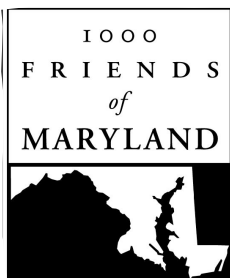
Transportation FOR Maryland is working to:
